- 3) (30 points) Suppose that a phone takes five hours to build in the USA and two hours to build in China. A computer takes 10 hours to build in the USA and 8 hours to build in China. Which country has an absolute advantage in phones and which has an absolute advantage in computers? Explain your logic. Which country has a comparative advantage in phones and which has a comparative advantage in computers? Explain your logic. Find a trade which will make both countries better off. Explain how you know it will make both better off.
- 4) (15 points) What are MRT and MRS? Why should they be equal?
